

STARTERS

The Nude Study Menu represents a selection of performance pieces, created by Maarten van der Put, co-artistic director of United Cowboys.

There is the possibility to include one or more of these performances in various programs (festivals, theaters, events,...) as 'samples'. The following performances lend themsleves perfectly to be presented on location, but are also very suitable for more traditional settings (theater, dance stages).

Maarten van der Put's images depict women. Vulnerable women and at the same time defiant women who look you straight in the eye.

The performances do not convey pornographic associations, they actually concern 'matter' in an adornian way. Van der Put is fascinated with matter. The wooden table leg versus a soft breast. The barren, withered mattress versus the skin of a young woman. A piece of glass in the sole of a dancer's foot. And then, as if by accident, that nudity. Far away from the glance of the voyeur. Nothing obscene. They are silent naked women who are too vulnerable to be consumed. And therefore compellingly beautiful.

Animation of a living mattress. Slapstick. Then fragile girl's body versus heavy mattress. Feminin, intimate, emotional. Ending like a queen with the mattress wrapped around her like a king's robe.

FOUR

A thousand broken beer glasses. Mermaids in a sea of oil, meandering between coral. Sirens. Danger. Bated breath.

FIVE

Micro breathing. Japanese. Stunning expressive and enchanting naive. It's just meat. Perky tough.

SIX

Inordinate athletic. Unambitious. Obsessive. Ceaselessly spinning. Exhaustion, trembling, sweat.

SEVEN

Urban sound scape. Still. Interview without words. Portrait of youth. Lifecycle. Minimal. Frozen still life, in brigher and brighter light, that slowly thaws.

EIGHT

Feet – Toes – Flutter - Ballet – Fall – Bambi – Ballet – Fall. The highest elegance and the basic going down.

NINE

Nodding and shaking. Pleasing and turning in. Turning – turning – turning in. So confident, so vulnerable. Nodding and shaking.

Asian. Distant but near. Long Lost. Investigate. Surrender. Portrait. Self portrait?

Light and body. A refined play. Concealed and yet undressed.

Inspiration for the Nude Studies Maarten van der Put

I am fascinated by the performer and the body confronted with just one other quantity: plain, unequivocal, artificial surroundings. We need to go back to the source of our appearance, of our bodies. The shiver on the one hand and the power on the other of just 'being'. This idea is inspired, amongst others, by the fascination of the Ancient Greeks for the human body. Their passion in reflecting skins texture in their sculptures, the touch and liveliness in approach of muscle stones, the attitude, in the both heroic and also vulnerability of the human body.

In my point of view, nudity nowadays is shown way too little in all silence and sincerity; in a form in which we could consider the body as a wonder as well as a natural phenomenon. No science, no religion, but pure amazement.
